Lesson 6: Money (Де́ньги)

Verbs with Money

Let's start by reviewing some of the different verbs you can use with money:

- to earn money is 'зараба́тывать де́ньги' – to receive money from doing work.

For example, я зарабатываю 100 000 рублей в месяц (I earn 100,000 rubles per month).

- to spend money is 'тра́тить де́ньги' – to use money to pay for things.

For example, я трачу 30 000 рублей в месяц на еду (I spend 30,000 rubles per month on food).

- to waste money is 'транжи́рить де́ньги' – to spend a lot for insignificant things.

For example, я транжирю деньги на кофе (I waste money on coffee).

- to save money is '**эконо́мить де́ньги'** the opposite of 'транжирить деньги' to spend carefully, with caution.
- to save up is 'копить деньги' to save money for some thing.

For example, я коплю деньги на новую машину (I am saving up for a new car).

Earning and Saving Money

The general money you receive for doing your job is called salary (за́работанная пла́та or зарпла́та). Some jobs include extra payments for great performance or at the end of some period – bonus (пре́мия).

The salary can be paid in cash (наличные) or transferred to your bank account (банковский счёт) into the bank (банк) of your choice. Cash can be banknotes (банкнота от купю́ра) and coins (моне́та). You keep them in a wallet (кошлёк).

There are not so many banks accounts in Russia for everyday life, just two:

- **Расчётный счёт** – an account where you can receive money and pay out from almost without any limitations. Used for day-to-day spending. For more convinient spending, a credit card (**креди́тная ка́рта** or **креди́тка**) is often used to spend money from your account.

- **Ба́нковский вклад** – a bank account with some restrictions on withdrawals and deposits. For example, some have conditions where you cannot withdraw during some period, and if you do you'd lose your interest (**проце́нт**).



Every month, you receive a statement (вы́писка) in the mail or online. The statement shows your transactions (опера́ция) – money spent or received and your balance (оста́ток) (аmount of money available).

You can withdraw (**снима́ть**) or deposit (**кла́сть**) money to or from your bank account via ATM (**банкома́т**) or via a cashier (**касси́р**) at your bank.

You can earn money by selling (продава́ть) some things.

Finally, let's learn some words for economic class. If you have a lot of money, then you are rich (бога́ч (noun), бога́тый (adjective)). If you have average wealth, then you are middle-class (сре́дний класс). If you are short on money, you are poor (бедня́к (noun), бе́дный (adjective)).

Spending money

Usually, you use the money by buying (покупа́ть) some things.

If something costs a lot, such a thing is expensive (дорога́я) and if it is too expensive

for you, you can say 'I cannot afford it' (я не мо́гу себе́ э́того позво́лить).

When something is cheap, it is called 'недорого́й' or 'дешёвый'.

If you use your money for charity, it is called 'де́лать поже́ртвования'. For example, to charity organizations (благотвори́тельная организа́ция).

People who like to share and give money are called generous (**щéдрый**), and the opposite – **скупо́й**, **жа́дный**.

Borrowing & Lending Money

Another thing you can do with money is to borrow (заня́ть or взять в долг) or lend (одолжи́ть) it. Usually, these words are related to friends of family. If you go to a bank, you take out a loan (креди́т, брать креди́т).

When you take out a loan or borrow money, you owe (быть до́лжным) this amount of money to the person or entity who gave it to you.

The verb for repaying a debt (долг) is 'отдава́ть долг' in case of borrowing money and 'вы́платить кредит' for a bank loan.
