Lesson 7: Walking on the Street


Building (зда́ние)

And now let's go outside and look around for new words.

Street in Russian is у́лица, but улица also means everything that's not inside the house. So to go outside will be 'пойти́ (вы́йти) на у́лицу'. Or for example, in case of the rain - 'на у́лице дождь'.

So, we walk outside the house (дом), if it is residential, or a building (зда́ние) for all buildings whether residential or not. If it is a multistory building, it is called многоэта́жное здание and the story is 'этаж', and we walk out from the porch (подъезд).

In lesson 1, we already tolked about крыша, гараж, подвал, дверь, so you can check yourself. The balcony is **балко́н**, and many old buildings have a column (**коло́нна**) on their front side (фаса́д). The open or glazed premise built onto the house is a veranda (вера́нда). Stairs is ле́стница.



Street (у́лица)

The street is usually divided into road (доро́га) and sidewalk (тротуа́р). On the road you usually see cars (автомоби́ль от маши́на), buses (авто́бус), unless this street is for pedestrians (пешехо́д) only. The place where pedestrians can cross the road is a pedestrian crossing (пешеходный переход). The traffic is regulated by traffic lights (светофо́р) and road signs (доро́жный знак).

The road is lit up with street lights (фона́рь) when it is dark which are placed on the sidewalks along with the trees (де́рево).




Yard (двор)

The place between houses for playgrounds (де́тская площа́дка), resting, BBQ under the open sky (не́бо) is called a yard (двор).

The yard often has benches (**скаме́йка**), so you can sit (**сиде́ть**) there. Some urns (**у́рна**) for the litter (**му́сор**) and lampposts (**фона́рный столб**) to light when it's dark or just to keep electric wires (**про́вод**) away from the ground.

A playground is usually fenced around with a fence (забо́р or огра́да), and has a swing (каче́ли). Children play games (игра́) on the ground (площа́дка) while their parents watch them from a bench.



Walking on the street

Let's take a walk along the street.

The street along the river (река́) or on the seaside is called an embankment (на́бережная). On the first floor (Russians do not have ground floor, so the story on the ground is the first) is usually used by shops (магази́н) which you can easily distinguish by their show cases (витри́на), cafés (кафе), barbershops (парикма́херская), pharmacies (апте́ка) etc.

Some shops use stands (**стенд**) and other advertisement (**рекла́ма**) to attract customers' (**клие́нт**) attention or to show their goods. A sign with the name of the shop or other organizations is called '**вы́веска**'.

There are some special buildings in the city, for example, churches (це́рковь), cathedrals (собо́р), mosques (мече́ть) or synagogues (синого́га).




Weather (пого́да)

Let's talk the weather!

The sun is '**со́лнце**'. If the sun is covered with clouds (**о́блако**), we call such weather cloudy (**о́блачно**). When coulds are too dark, we call them '**ту́ча**' and most likely there will soon be rain (**дождь**) maybe with thunder (**гроза́**) if it is warm, mostly in the late spring (**весна́**) or snow (**снег**) in winter (**зима́**). Sometimes you can see a rainbow (**ра́дуга**) during the rain. When the snow is falling we call it '**снегопа́д**'. If there are no clounds, we call such weather '**я́сно**'.

The dayly cycle is as follows: when the sun has just appeared, it called 'dawn' (рассве́т), and the morning (у́тро) starts. The fog (тума́н) usually appears that time in late summer (ле́то) or early autumn (о́сень). The day is 'день'. When the sun starts to decline, the evening (ве́чер) comes, and it ends with the sunset (зака́т). So the night (ночь) begins. At night you can see plenty of stars (звезда́) and the moon (луна́) or crescent (ме́сяц). And if the weather is really good, you can even see a milky way (мле́чный путь).


