

LESSON 3

VOWELS И AND Ы

M [ee] – Russian M is one of the so-called soft vowels (we will talk about them in the next lessons). It is shorter than the sound in the words 'people' and 'feet'. Try to make a short and long M sound. It is important to understand the position of your tongue. This will help you later when we speak about the soft consonants.

bI [ih] – Russian bi is unique. There is no such sound in English. I will teach how to pronounce it in several ways (watch the video).

- 1. Put a pencil between your teeth and push your tongue backwards. Then try to say 'its' several times. Now try it without the pencil.
- 2. Start with the long sound Y. Then try to smile really wide until you hear Ы.
- 3. Start with long II, then move your tongue back a little (you can use a spoon) until you hear bI.

In this lesson, you only need to understand the difference between your tongue positions. **И-position and Ы-position**.
