LETTER Й (И КРАТКОЕ)

In today's lesson, you will learn how to pronounce the sound of the letter Й.

There can be three positions of the letter Й.

- 1. Before a vowel it is pronounced as [y] in words like 'yoghurt', 'yet', and 'yank'.
- 2. After a vowel, it sounds like [y] in 'boy' or 'toy'.
- 3. Between two vowels, it is like [y] in the word 'coyote'.

Repeat after me: МАЙ (May), БОЙ (Battle), ЙОТА (Iota), КОЙОТ (Coyote).

Now practice with the audio exercise. We will need this sound in the next lesson, so be sure you understand it before moving on.
